Helping in the school canteen is an excellent way to become an active member of the school community, meet other parents and staff, gain food handling experience and help raise funds for the school.

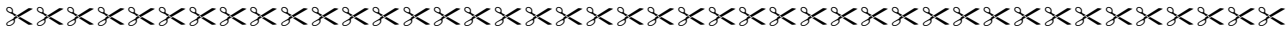

## Expression of Interest

### MGHS P&C ASSOCIATION FINANCIAL AUDITOR FOR 2010

The financial records of the MGHS P&C Association and the MGHS School Canteen, which is operated by the P&C Association, are required to be audited annually.

The MGHS P&C Association is seeking expressions of interest from members of the school community who would be able to offer their services as financial auditor for 2010.

As per the NSW P&C Federation handbook:

*The auditor does not need to be a qualified professional.*

*The auditor must possess appropriate skills and experience in auditing and financial record management together with an appreciation of the issues of probity as they relate to the role of association auditor. The auditor must not have or appear to have any conflict of interest arising, for example, from a personal or business relationship with an officer of the association and must be prepared to swear that the records are a true and correct statement of the information provided by the Treasurer.*

*Copies of audited accounts are forwarded to the Federation of P&C Associations of NSW within one month of the AGM at which they were presented.*
